**Volunteer Pediatric orthopaedic surgeon for occupied Palestinian territories (oPt) - Gaza**

### JOB SUMMARY

Successful candidate will conduct in the assigned Hospital in Gaza, specialized pediatric orthopedic surgeries as part of the MdM Surgical Team (EMT) with the aid of a second pediatric orthopedic surgeon, along with the necessary equipment and medical supplies needed.

### GEOGRAPHICAL SCOPE OF INTERVENTION:

The successful candidate will be based in Gaza.

### ORGANIZATION CHART

The candidate will report to the Medical Referent in Complex Crisis Unit at HQ in Madrid and MdM Spain General Coordinator in oPt.

### FUNCTIONS

#### Program:

- Pass consultation to the patients identified during the screening process.
- Review cases with the help of local staff
- Assist in the programming and execution of the surgical interventions identified.
- Identify technical and material needs.
- Advice about global case management (post-operative, follow up, new surgeries, rehabilitation, household based cares, others).
- Communicate with Outreach focal point of MdM.

#### Reporting:

- To report about activity results, needs, challenge and follow up needs under the template provided by MdM.

### REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS:

#### Academic background:

- Paediatric orthopaedics surgery specialist with experience of congenital malformations.

#### Language requirements:

- Knowledge of English would be an asset.

- Experience in managing complicated previously operated cases of ankle and hip joints.
